After serving as faculty in the Applied Developmental Psychology Minor at UCLA and as the Executive Director of the UCLA Infant Development Program, Dr. Shabazian accepted a dual appointment at Loyola Marymount University (LMU) serving as a tenured Professor at LMU's School of Education and as Director of the Award Winning LMU's Children's Center. She has authored several textbooks and peer-reviewed articles and regularly presents at conferences both nationally and internationally.
