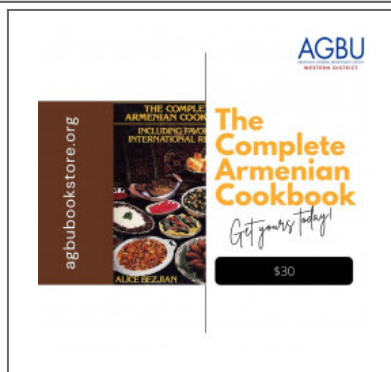
Become a Mentor
